This new partnership offers education benefits to lower overall tuition costs associated with attending Buena Vista University online or on-campus to full-time and part-time employees, as well as a spouse, domestic partner and dependents up to age 26 of full-time employees.

As a partner employee, you and your eligible family members qualify for up to a 30 percent discount per credit hour in the form of a BVU partner grant. This grant is for all online/hybrid undergraduate programs and our graduate program in Organizational Leadership. For those interested in attending our BVU Storm Lake campus, a BVU partner grant of up to \$2,000 annually will be available.

To be eligible for the BVU partner grant, please follow these steps:

1. Apply to Buena Vista University – www.bvu.edu/apply.
 - a. Select “Midwest Industries Inc.” as your partner employer on the application.
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). *This is required for undergraduate students, and preferred, but not required for graduate students.*
3. Request your human resources department submit your employment verification electronically to StrategicPartnerships@bvu.edu confirming employment.
 - a. Current BVU students are also eligible for grant funding. Current students will skip steps 1 & 2 and begin request for employment verification.

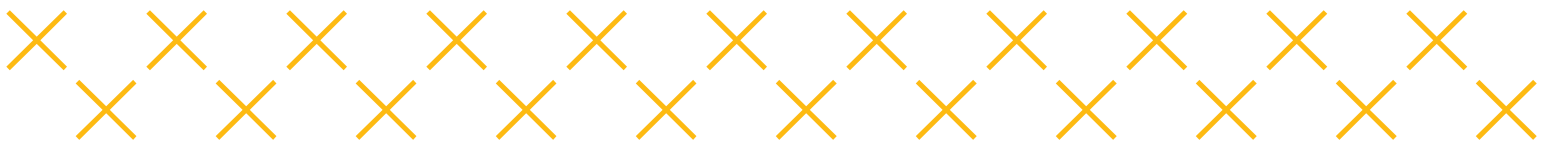

How to become eligible for education benefits:

1. Apply to BVU using their free [online application](#).
Be sure to fill out the partner/employer section listed on the application.
2. File the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#)
Use BVU's school code: 001847
3. Request your human resources department to submit your official letter of employment electronically to strategicpartnerships@bvu.edu confirming employment. Please state employee's work status (full-time or part-time) and if the student seeking admission is the employee, the employee's spouse/domestic partner, or the employee's dependent(s).
4. If you are a current BVU student, skip steps 1 & 2 and begin your request for the employment verification form and submit to strategicpartnerships@bvu.edu.

Course plans are tailored to fit each student, their goals, and their lifestyle. All students receive support from an enrollment counselor, academic advisor, and financial specialist. These dedicated staff members will assist students through the enrollment process and the entire duration of the program. WHAT ARE THE BUENA VISTA UNIVERSITY EDUCATION BENEFITS?

BVU and Midwest Industries Inc. have created a Strategic Partnership to benefit employees and their family members looking to further their education.

WHO QUALIFIES FOR EDUCATION BENEFITS?

Full-time and part-time employees of Midwest Industries Inc. qualify for benefits. In addition, a spouse or domestic partner, and dependents (up to age 26) of full-time employees qualify. *All undergraduate programs at BVU (online/hybrid or on campus) are available for students with a minimum of a high school diploma or GED. The organizational leadership graduate program is available for students with a minimum of a bachelor's degree. All students must meet the admissions requirements and be accepted into their desired program.*

HOW DO I APPLY FOR EDUCATION BENEFITS?

1. Apply to Buena Vista University at bvu.edu/apply.
On the application, list Midwest Industries Inc. as your current employer. Spouses, domestic partners, and dependents utilizing the benefit will list their relationship to the Midwest Industries Inc. employee.
2. File your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov.
3. Request your human resources department submit your official employment verification electronically to strategicpartnerships@bvu.edu. Verification must include employee's name, employee's work status (full-time or part-time), name of student seeking admission to BVU, and relationship of student to employee.

In the case that employment ends, the student associated with BVU education benefits will be removed from the BVU partner grant in the following semester. The student will be responsible for notifying BVU of the employment change.

WHAT IF I AM A CURRENT BVU STUDENT OR MY SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT CHILD IS ATTENDING BVU?

Current BVU students can skip steps 1 & 2 and begin with step 3 of verifying employment.
